One day she broke her father's rule. She couldn't wait any longer - she was dying to see the world beyond the water's edge.






Then she saw something very peculiar - it was a ship! On the ship was the most handsome man Ariel had ever seen. And he had leas!

Ariel was very unhappy because there was only one thing she wanted - to explore the world on land. She dreamed of seeing cities and meeting people.





Ariel was so angry that she never wanted to see her father again. She was determined to become a human and live on land. This meant that she had to find the sea witch.




Number 8-13

An especially powerful wave crashed into the boat and knocked the young man into the water. He was unconscious!




